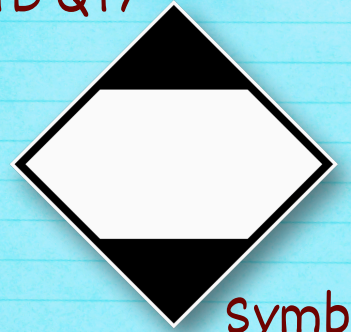


LIMITED QUANTITY SHIPMENTS (LTD QTY)

LTD QTY



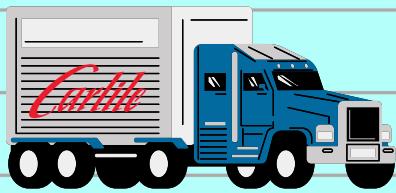
Symbol

Limited quantity shipments are not regulated as hazmat over the road.
However, Limited quantities are fully regulated when transported by air or by water.

Not Regulated!

Ground Transport

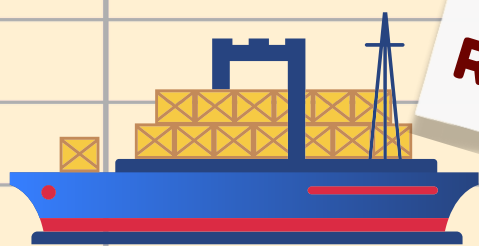
Limited quantities are NOT regulated for ground shipping!



Only requirement: freight must be marked with LTD QTY label

Vessel Transport

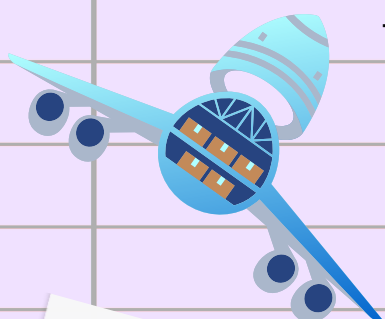
LTD QTY placards required if trailer is only transporting limited quantities, and no other regulated hazmat.



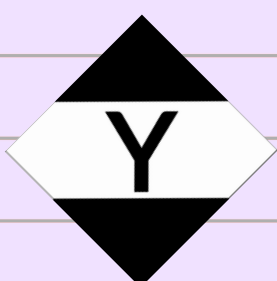

The letter "Y" is required on the air LTD QTY label

What does fully regulated mean?

SHIPPING PAPERS: Limited quantity shipments must be fully declared on shipping documents in ISHP order:

- **I** - Identification number
- **S** - Shipping name
- **H** - Hazard Class
- **P** - Packing group
- Emergency Response phone number must be included on shipping document!

Hazmat declaration must include **(Limited Quantity)** or **(LTD QTY)** at the end of the hazmat description.

Example: **UN1263, Paint, 3, PG II (LTD QTY)**

MARKINGS AND LABELS

- Hazmat package must display LTD QTY label.
- If hazmat is liquid, orientation arrows are required.
- Name and address of consignee (final destination) must be listed physically on the freight.



LIMITED QUANTITY REQUIREMENTS

- Package may not exceed 30 kg mass (66lbs).
- Limited Quantity label must be applied to freight.
- The words **(limited quantity)** or **(LTD QTY)** must be added to the end of the hazmat description in parenthesis on shipping papers.
