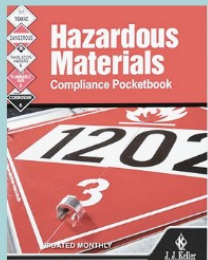

The **Hazardous Materials Table (HMT)** lists 3,000 hazmat shipping names, but it does not cover every hazardous material.

The **DOT** provides two tools to use to solve this problem; the placement of the letters **n.o.s.** at the end of the proper shipping name, and providing the letter **G** for **generic** in column one of the hazmat table.

How to check if HazMat is **Generic** using the Hazardous Materials Table:

If the symbol **G** is in **column (1)** - a chemical or technical description is required immediately after **n.o.s.** in parenthesis.



If **column (1)** is empty in the Hazardous Materials Table, your proper shipping name will **NOT** require chemical or technical descriptions in parentheses.



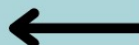

	Aerosols, flammable, n.o.s.	2.1	UN1950
	Petroleum distillates, n.o.s. or Petroleum products, n.o.s.	3	UN1268

These UN numbers have a **G** in column 1, and require info in parenthesis.



UN1986, Alcohols, flammable toxic, n.o.s (methanol) , 3, PG I
UN1760, Corrosive liquids, n.o.s. (hydroxide) , 8, PG III
UN1993, Flammable liquid, n.o.s. (isopropanol) , 3, PG II

UN1987, Alcohols, n.o.s , 3, PG I
UN1950, Aerosols, flammable, n.o.s , 2.1
UN1268, Petroleum distillates, n.o.s , 3, PG I



These UN numbers do not have **G** in column 1, and **DO NOT** require chemical name in parenthesis.

IMPORTANT:

Don't forget to check **column 1** in the **HazMat Table**. If you see a **G**, you MUST have a chemical or technical name in parenthesis immediately after the **n.o.s.**
