

Proper Hazmat Shipping Order

Remember the acronym "I ship" (I.S.H.P)

Hazmat descriptions can be found in the red **Hazardous Materials Compliance Pocketbook** under the **Hazardous Materials Table (HMT)**

UN1263, Paint, 3, PG I

I

IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

The **UN/NA** identification number should be listed first in the hazmat description (UN1263)

S

SHIPPING NAME

Proper shipping name (PSN) immediately follows the ID number, and will be shown in Roman font - *not italics* (Paint). If the phrase "N.O.S" (not otherwise specified) is the the **PSN**, a technical or chemical name must be included in parenthesis.

H

HAZARD CLASS

The **hazard class** is the third entry of the proper shipping description (3). Ensure your placards on your trailer match the hazard class on shipping papers!

P

PACKING GROUP

Verify if the hazmat on your shipping paperwork does indeed have a **packing group (PG I)** **NOTE:** Class 2 and Class 7 hazmat **NEVER** have packing groups!
